

# Camping and caravan sites

**Housedean Farm**, Brighton Road, Lewes, BN7 3JW, Tel: 07919 668816. Open: April-October. Tent pitches, small campervans, 2 bell tents (furnished or unfurnished that sleep up to 6 people each), furnished shepherd hut (sleeps up to 2 adults and 1 child) + 3 wooden camping pods (2 x two single beds and 1 x double and single). Showers, toilets, wash up facilities, communal fridge and freezer, fire pits for campfires (logs, kindling, firelighters available to purchase) and bicycle hire. 2 night minimum on weekends or 3 night min. on bank holiday weekends. Bus no 28 or 29 bus from Brighton city centre stops outside the campsite/ farm. Traditional working farm with great views on the South Downs Way. [www.housedean.co.uk](http://www.housedean.co.uk).

**Pop Up Brighton**, Bevendean Farm, Racehill, Brighton, BN2 6AF, Tel: 0777 1535350 or 07812 605094. Open: May-August. Tent pitches, furnished teepees and bell tents. Showers, toilets, wash-up facilities, meals available, supper hampers, lockable cabinets, electric power supply, fire pits, hot water bottles, pamper tables, dogs not permitted, groups welcome. **Brighton Caravan Club Site**, East Brighton Park, off Wilson Avenue, Brighton, BN2 5TS, Tel: 01273 626546. Open: All year. Touring caravans/campervans (no static caravans), tent pitches (Jan-Sept only), furnished pods (sleep up to 2 adults + 2 young children). Electric hook up, shower and toilet blocks, laundry facilities, disabled toilets and shower room, baby and toddler washrooms, playground, dogs accepted, no large single sex groups. Tent pitches, bell tent, shepherd's hut and Welsh Douglas Fir hut (no caravans, motorhomes or campervans). Washing and wash-up facilities in barn, eco toilet, fire pits and wood available, well behaved dogs welcome, nearby pubs for meals. Limited parking available - £5 per stay. No 17 bus from Brighton city centre stops nearby (ask driver for Pyecombe footbridge and walk over footbridge). Tent pitches in private woodland glades plus retro caravan, gypsy caravan, holiday bus, a 'holicopter' and curvy cabin for hire. Toilets, showers and wash up areas, environmentally friendly campfire grills and open fires available to cook on. Please note that this is a quiet campsite for people who enjoy nature. No stereos or radios and no noise after 11pm. Dogs on leads at all times (tents only). No unaccompanied under 18s without prior arrangement. Camping & Caravanning club members only (non members can apply for membership on site). Family run campsite in 23 acres of fields and oak trees, 1 mile from the South Downs National Park. Toilets, washing up area, no hot water or showers, firepits with every pitch and wood available to purchase, pub serving food and local ale next door with large garden and children's swings and slides. Beautiful rural site with views and access to the South Downs but next to country road so some traffic noise. 10-15 minute walk from Plumpton train station. Toilets, showers, washing up area, campfire pits (firewood available to purchase), well behaved dogs on leads welcome. Area of outstanding natural beauty within the South Downs National Park and with immediate access to the South Downs Way. 10 minutes walk to Firle village and pub.
